DOUBLE TAKE, AN EXHIBITION OF WORK BY EIGHTEEN CONTEMPORARY ARTISTS OPENS JULY 15, 1978.

DOUBLE TAKE, an exhibition of recent works by eighteen contemporary artists opens at The New Museum on July 15, 1978. Continuing through September 2, this show presents a second look at the work of those artists who participated in the first three shows organized by the museum between its inception in January 1977 and its opening at the present location in November of the same year.

The exhibition consists of more recent works than those shown previously and includes paintings, sculptures, installations and works on paper, representing a diversity of approaches and concerns.
