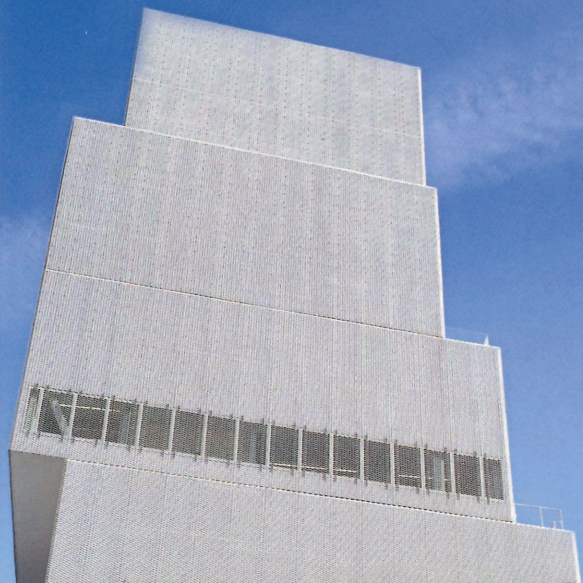

The New Museum is the only museum with the mission to promote new art and new ideas, and the only museum in Manhattan devoted exclusively to contemporary art. Founded in 1977, the New Museum was conceived as a center for exhibitions, information, and documentation about living artists. The New Museum is a leading destination for the art of our times and is respected internationally for the adventurousness and global scope of its curatorial program.

The New Museum has evolved over the past three decades, from a one-room office on Hudson Street in 1977 to the inauguration of its first freestanding, dedicated building in 2007. A site of ongoing experimentation and questioning of what art and institutions can be in the twenty-first century, the New Museum continues to look to the future through programming that is open, fearless, and alive.
