Founded in 1986, ACT-UP (AIDS Coalition to Unleash Power) is a diverse, non-partisan and grass-roots organization dedicated to developing political and medical justice in the AIDS crisis. Its installation at The New Museum, through a variety of print and electronic media, will provide up-to-date information regarding the epidemic as well as depicting the crisis in historical perspective. As ACT-UP observes, "The AIDS crisis casts a very wide net that now ensnares men, women and children of every race, class, and sexual preferance. We intend to expose the gravity of the problem and suggest that history will judge this society by its response to what is perhaps the worst medical disaster of the century." A provisional title of ACT-UP's installation might be: LET THE RECORD SHOW . . .
